Item #4 - Monthly Fire Department Report.

Item #10 – Discuss/Recommend 10 Minute Parking Stalls in Front of Quiznos.

It was requested that this item be put on the agenda again since Basri wasn't able to attend the last meeting due to a family emergency. Basri from Quiznos explained that he would like two stalls in front of his building for 10 minute parking since 80% of his business is pickup. Ald. Voss asked if he could use the ally in back of his building for people to pick up orders. Basri explained that there is not enough room in back of the building. Ald. Heron stated that he thought this was a simple request and that this was not setting a precedent. The council can look at requests by a case by case basis. Captain Poellot raised the issue of enforcement and that they may have to rely on businesses to report problems.

Basri explained that he would only call the police for people who do it on purpose and that he doesn't expect the police to check on the stalls every 10 minutes. He expressed that he didn't mind if other businesses used the spots also. There was further discussion on putting a time range on the two stalls. Motion by Ald. Sabel, second by Ald. Nitschke to go to council for approval two 10 minutes parking stalls in front of Quiznos with a time range of 11:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
