Review Resolution 4272-2008 Review of Vehicle Registration Fee Ordinance Annually with possible recommendation of amendments to Ordinance 1013-2008 Vehicle Registration Fee.

Resolution 4355-2009 (Approve the 2010 Budget and Set the 2009 Tax Mill Rate for the City of Mayville).
