TAG Center Report

- We had to cancel the spring session of swim lessons due to a lack of available instructors. In the future we will have a fall session and a winter session. This will coincide with the winter and spring sports seasons as most of our lifeguards are in high school sports.
- Repairs were made to the Menerga Units for the pool. We have filed an insurance claim with the cities boiler insurance.
- We purchased 5 spinning bikes. The spinning program went over very well this past winter. Money came from the Endowment Fund.
- Summer hours will take effect on May 27.

- Attendance for the Month of March was 5,723. Walk-ins for the month were 2,527 for total building attendance of 8,250.
