#### **Item #2 Discuss/Approve Changes to Outdoor Pool Operations due to flooding**

Mike presented information relating to the recent flooding at the May Park Outdoor Pool. There was structural damage to one of the piers and Mike has some concerns about the diving platform.

There was considerable discussion relating to the timetable to get the pool up and running again for the year and what the costs would be. Mike estimates it would take at least until the first week of July to get it drained, cleaned, and open.

Mike expressed concern about the status of the Lifeguards and the need to keep them working so they don't look for other jobs.

The TAG Center would be available to move the Open Swims to ensure a seamless transition for swimmers this summer

The Commission agreed that there would be added expense with limited income potential for the rest of the season.

Motion by Weyer, seconded by Luehring to approve closing the Outdoor Pool for the remainder of the summer and moving all open swims. This motion will also include creating a season swim pass for \$55 for the summer. Motion carried unanimously.
