RE: Report to Public Works for meeting 12/22/09

I will not be attending tonight's meetings as I will be out of town, so I am submitting a written report.

- 330 Breckenridge St. – There was a private water service line break at the Brookside Dr Condos. This is the 3rd break on one of their private service lines to their buildings. The break was due to faulty installation of the line. Town and Country Construction installed a new line to the building last week at the cost of the property owner.
- 225 S Main St – If you remember last year I ordered the homeowner at 225 S Main St to abandon a private well in their back yard. The well was collapsing and was very dangerous situation for anyone nearing it. The homeowner who was not living in the building initially refused to abandon the well and eventually had their service disconnected until the well was properly abandoned. This past month the homeowner finally contacted me to inform me that the well was abandoned and ready for inspection. The abandoned well was inspected and water service has been restored.
- Ultra Violet Disinfection – Plans for the UV System have been sent to the DNR for approval and advertisement for bids have been placed in the Dodge County Pioneer, with bid opening to be held 12/29/09 @ 11:00 a.m. at the WWTP. There will be no borrowing for this project as it will be paid through replacement funds. Once on line this project is projected by the Engineer to save the wastewater utility approximately \$31, 000 per year.
