Item #4 – Monthly Utilities Report.

**A. Cross Connection Inspection Program.**

Ron Wellner reported that the cross connection inspections will start at the end of the month. They will be doing the public buildings first and then move on to the more hazardous facilities in Mayville. The inspections are being done by Hydro Design.

**B. Heating Line Repair at Wastewater Treatment Plant.**

The heating line at the wastewater treatment plant has broken for the fourth time. They were told that it is breaking at the joints. The material that it is being held together with needs to be replaced.

**C. Hiring of Plan Operator.**

Ron reported that Peggy Schultz has been hired as the new plan operator. She will be starting March 25<sup>th</sup>. She has a major in biology and a minor in microbiology.

Item #5 – Monthly DPW Report.

**A. Preparation for Spring Thaw.**

Vern reported that with spring approaching and in preparation for the spring thaw they have completed going through the creek crossings. They have also got the dam gates operating again. The gates were frozen shut.

**B. Equipment Repairs Update.**

They recently had a drive shaft go out on the front end loader. The cost was \$8,000 to be replaced.

**C. Snow Removal, Salt Availability, Pot Hole Repair Update.**

They have a salt and sand mixture available if we get more snow this spring. Vern reported that they were receiving complaints that the pot holes weren't repaired soon enough. Some of the holes were filled with ice however they have recently got out and are now filling the pot holes.

There were numerous questions on various streets that had some patch work needing to be done and what the status was on getting them fixed or if the areas could be refilled with gravel. Vern and Ron gave the council an update on those areas.
