Item #2 – Approve Minutes of May 22, 2007 meeting.

Item #4 – Monthly Utilities Report.

- A. Utility Activity Update – Vern stated that Ron Wellner is ill and is not able to attend the meeting. He has nothing to report.
- B. Date & Time for Next Meeting – Nothing was reported.

Item #5 – Monthly DPW Report.

- A. North Main Street Project Update – Vern stated that the driveway aprons have been repaired.
- B. 2007 Projects Update – Painting on the Lincoln Lane pedestrian bridge project is done. Approximately a dozen boards were placed on the bridge. For the Green Bay Drive project, the paving was done last week. They need to seed the area yet.
- C. Department Update – Vern reported that the crews are doing line painting and removing trees in terrace areas and helping remove some trees at the golf club. Vern stated that he and Ron Guse will be working on the parking scheme for the Legion next week. He also reported that they have been getting some concerns from citizens regarding the river elevation. Ald. Voss asked if he knew about a tree down in the river and if we were going to be taking care of it. Vern stated that he didn't know anything about it but that normally if it is in front of a citizen's house it is their responsibility.

Item #7 – Discuss/Recommend Moving Bench on Corner of Bridge and Main Streets.

Vern stated that he has looked at the bench on the corner of Bridge and Main Streets. He explained that Bridge Street Pub had to take out a revocable occupancy permit awhile back. He feels that if we move it to the north he would agree to the change and feels this won't cause any problems. The bench would stay along the curb and in the street right of way. Ald. McKinnon also stated that he checked out the bench and feels the walkway space between the bench and building is very tight. Ald. Sabel stated that the city would take care of the costs of moving the bench. He also stated that this is only a one case thing. He doesn't see any others that have problems. Motion by Liebenow, second by Voss to approve moving the bench on the corner of Bridge and Main Streets to the north closer to Main Street Liquor. Motion carried unanimously.
