I will be on vacation November 21, 2011, so I am submitting a written report.

1. Barwig Lifstation – Here is a list of bids submitted:

1. Advanced Construction, Inc	\$459,852.06
2. Allen Steele Co., Inc	\$379,464.50
3. PTS Contractors Inc	\$323,677.00
4. Rawson Contractors Inc	\$489,453.00
5. Town & Country Construction	\$377,156.50
6. Woleske Construction	\$444,000.00

My estimate for the construction portion of this project was \$396,000, the low apparent bid is PTS Contractors Inc of Green Bay, WI, \$323,677. After the Engineer's review of the bids and recommendation the bids and recommendation the bids will be reviewed by the Utilities Commission and recommended to the Common Council for approval.

2. Well #3 Radium

Our latest radium result was 4.91 pCi/l. I have received and reviewed the treatment facility plans from MSA. The plans will be submitted to the DNR for approval by December 1, 2011.

Deanna-

I will be up north on Monday and will not be able to attend the Nov. Committee meeting. Therefore, please consider this a report on the three agenda items for the DPW Committee under "Planning & Engineering".

- 1) 2011 St. & Resurfacing – All asphalt paving work has been completed on both the City streets and the golf course parking lot. The asphalt curb as installed along the west and north edge of the parking lot to help prevent stormwater run off to the adjacent properties to the west. Following the installation, I went visited the site during a rain event and saw that this is working. In the fall, leaves will have to be kept clear in the northwest corner of the parking lot in order to let the water discharge from the curb freely. Otherwise it seems to be working well. Paving was also done in between the golf cart sheds, which the golf course was to be billed for separately.
- 2) Wool Factory Bridge – Project has been completed and according to the assistant highway commissioner has been completed within budget. In speaking with the assistant highway commissioner it may be awhile before we see a bill for the City's portion of the project.
- 3) WISLR Pavement Ratings – Wisconsin Department of Transportation requires municipalities to annually update the pavement ratings for their city streets. These ratings need to be kept update in order to remain eligible for possible grants and funding thru WisDOT. As an example, the City just received \$15,000 of Local Road Improvement Program monies through WisDOT for the 2011 Street and Utility Improvements. This money went towards the concrete street pavement on Henninger Street. Pavement ratings will be updated and uploaded on WISLR site by the end of November.
