Item #2 – Discuss/Recommend designating the two parking spots on North Main Street, on west side of street, just south of Williams Street as valet parking for the Audubon Inn from 2 p.m.-11 p.m. daily.

Keith Hill, 95 Shore Lane, Mayville, talked about wanting to do valet parking for hotel and restaurant guests at the Audubon Inn. Valet parking is one of the key components looked at for service levels for hotels which will help him get the national exposure and star rating needed. He plans on purchasing 16 passes at the public library lot to accommodate the parking. Audubon Inn currently has a 10 minute parking spot on Williams Street.

Motion by Ald. Hohmann, second by Ald. Schmidt to recommend designating the two parking spots on North Main Street, on west side of street, just south of Williams Street as valet parking for the Audubon Inn from 2 p.m.-11 p.m. daily to Common Council. Motion carried 2-1. Ald. Toellner voted no.
